# Associate Degrees for Transfer Frequently Asked Questions

What is an **AA** and **AS** Degree?

**AA** and **AS** are acronyms for Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees that are designed specifically for transfer to the California State University System. The degrees are the results of Senate Bill 1440, a transfer bill that required the California Community Colleges to offer associate degrees for transfer in many of the most popular majors, and for the CSU to provide California Community College students who have earned an **AA** or **AS** degree. These degrees can be completed in 60 transferable semester units (or 90 quarter units) and include coursework in general education, major preparation and electives.

How are the **AA** and **AS** degrees different from the associate degrees that community colleges already offer?

Students completing an **AA** or **AS** degree are eligible to transfer to the CSU system with junior standing. Community college students who have earned an associate degree but not an **AA** or **AS** degree are eligible to transfer to the CSU system with sophomore standing.
